- ✓ The authors are required to use the following format:
 - The abstract should be between 250-400 words;
 - Length: 10 to 15 page, font Times New Roman, size 12, single space, A4 paper size, margin 1 inch or 2,5 cm.
 - Author(s) names, affiliation, correspondence address, and email address should be provided on the first page.
 - Three-six keywords should be mentioned by the author(s).
 - Tables and figures should be placed in their appropriate location and mentioned in the paper.
 - References: APA style.
