Keynote speakers



Annalisa Prencipe is Professor at Bocconi University (Italy) where she holds the KPMG Chair in Accounting. Annalisa is member of the Bocconi University Board and the former President of the *European Accounting Association* (2021-2023). She is internationally known for her research on financial and non-financial reporting, disclosure, corporate governance, family and private firms.



Donald Pagach is Professor of Accounting and Director of Research for Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) Initiative at North Carolina State University (USA). He is a world leader in the area of risk management and forecasting. He has conducted extensive academic research that examines characteristics of organizations that implement enterprise risk management and how investors in the marketplace value the embrace by organizations of ERM processes.



Mukesh Garg is Associate Professor of Accounting at Monash University (Australia). He has published in high-quality journals on issues related to financial reporting, auditing, capital markets, and climate change. Mukesh is currently a member of the Stakeholder Reporting Committee and Auditing, Assurance, and Ethics Standards Committee of the European Accounting Association. He has been Deputy Head of the Department and a member of the Academic Board at Monash University. Besides, he has experience working at the Australian Accounting Standards Board as Research and Education Principal.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The Workshop offers a meeting opportunity for academics and practitioners interested in recent developments and research projects regarding financial reporting. Therefore, we encourage submitting empirical and theoretical papers and case studies broadly addressing financial reporting issues.

SESSIONS

The Workshop offers two types of sessions:

- **Parallel session with discussant**, which includes papers that are sufficiently developed to benefit from an in-depth discussion;
- **Research forum**, which includes early-stage papers and research proposals, and aims to challenge and improve the research idea and design.
